HOPE: RUBY & ROWEN

Ruby and Rowen were born via emergency c-section at 34 weeks. Rowen revealed a heart murmur and was taken to a cardiac intensive care unit.



Rowen underwent many surgeries: a heart repair at 6.5 weeks, surgery to open a constricted airway and placement of a G-Tube. Rowen was in the hospital for 3.5 months and returned many times in the following 2 years. Today, Rowen is 5 years old and continues to fight.



REMEMBER: MATTHEW

At 40 weeks, the Schmitts were told that their baby boy, Matthew, had died from umbilical cord strangulation. He was born the next morning, June 14. The Schmitts walk to help prevent another family from feeling their same pain and to provide a space for Matthew to leave his mark on the world.



CELEBRATE: ARLO

Arlo was born via emergency c-section at 32 weeks due to complications from placenta previa. He weighed 4 lbs 9 oz. Arlo spent 35 days in the NICU battling jaundice, apnea, destats and bradycardia. Today, Arlo is an adventurous 3.5 year old who loves his big brother!
